Dear Parishioners:

In this bulletin you will find the statistics for the **spiritual report** for the calendar year 2011. In large part, the numbers are very close to what we reported for the year 2010. We have seen modest increases in the total number of parishioners, in the number of children receiving religious education, and in the percentage of parishioners at Sunday Mass. That is very good.

However, the overall picture continues to present very grave challenges for our future. As you can see, we bury three times the number of parishioners we baptize. That means that the Catholic community will continue to get smaller over the years. We are not replacing ourselves. It is true that every month we have new parishioners sign up, and we have some people returning to the practice of the faith. That is a blessing for us. However, the number of new parishioners coming in does not match the number of parishioners we lose by death, by loss of mobility, or change of residence in order to be with their children out of town. In addition, of the 13,085 parishioners we have, a little over 40% are over the age of 65. In fact, about 15% are over the age of 80. Those percentages are roughly true for the group of parishioners who are present at Mass at the weekend, not just the total group of parishioners. And so, we can expect the decline in the number of parishioners to be rapid over the next 10 years. It is just a factor of the natural aging process.

We should not become discouraged by these figures. They are the reality. But they are not the whole reality. We cannot measure the numbers of people who have deepened their faith over the past year. We cannot calculate how many people experienced a deep conversion and turned their lives around because of the ministry of the parish. We cannot estimate how many people took on a more regular life of prayer last year. These people are present among us. These moments of grace certainly took place for many people. I have witnessed them. We just can't measure these moments or quantify them like other statistics. In a sense, these kinds of growth in holiness are the real measure of the success of any parish. I trust that the Lord is working among us, and that our lives are a reflection of God's work among us. I give thanks to God for all the many gifts He has shared with us during the year 2011. We count on His continued blessings.

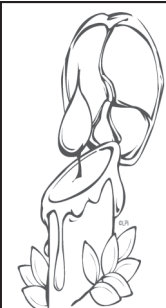

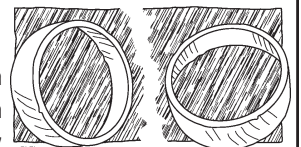

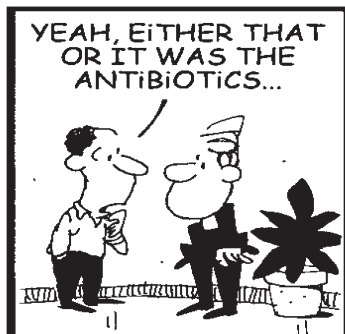
